

# AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION

between

**STATE INSTITUTION «SYTENKO INSTITUTE OF SPINE AND JOINT  
PATHOLOGY NATIONAL ACADEMY OF SCIENCES OF UKRAINE»  
(SI «SISJP NAMSU») (Kharkiv, Ukraine)**

and

**“THE NATIONAL CENTER OF REHABILITATION AND  
PROSTHETICS OF DISABLED” Agency for the Development of Medical  
and Social Services of the Republic of Uzbekistan  
(Tashkent, Uzbekistan)**

State institution «Sytenko institute of spine and joint pathology national academy of sciences of Ukraine» and “The national center of rehabilitation and prosthetics of disabled” Agency for the Development of Medical and Social Services of the Republic of Uzbekistan represented by its head physician Kayumov Taxir Pottaxovich, hereinafter collectively referred to as the “Parties”, taking into account mutual interests and being confident that this collaboration shall be mutually beneficial, have agreed to sign the Agreement.

This is a framework agreement outlining general principles and terms of collaboration. No provisions of this Agreement shall contradict the national legislation of any Party.

Article 1.

The Parties agree to develop collaboration in the area of medical education and medical science.

Article 2.

The parties agree on the following priority areas of collaboration:

2.1 Perform joint projects in the areas of medical education, medical science and healthcare, based on research programs and contracts concluded by the Parties for each joint research project.

2.2 Hold joint research and educational events: symposia, conferences, seminars, workshops, schools, round tables, and meetings; participate in research forums organized by the Parties.

2.3 Exchange students, residents and PhD students for short-term training courses.

2.4 Exchange research and teaching staff to give lectures and exchange experience.

2.5 Joint application for grants and awards.

2.6 This Agreement does not impose financial obligations on the Parties.

Article 3.

The Parties agree that all activities under Article 2 of this Agreement shall be implemented based on contracts concluded by the Parties for each joint project, as well as research programs and work plans thoroughly developed by the Parties, containing information on the joint events, organizational and financial conditions.

Article 4.

The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under Article 2

of this Agreement shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by the Parties prior to the initiation thereof.

Article 5.

All amendments, supplements and addendums to the present Agreement constitute its integral part and have equal legal force, provided that they are made in writing and duly signed by the authorized representatives of the Parties.

Article 6.

The Agreement shall take effect as of the date of signing it by the Parties and shall remain in force for 5 (five) years.

Article 7.

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with Ukraine and Uzbekistan legislation and each Party agrees to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Ukraine Courts and Uzbekistan Courts as regards any claim or matter arising under this Agreement.

Article 8.

Both Parties should comply to not using the name, logo or any trademark without the written permission of the other Party obtained in advance.

The Agreement shall be prolonged until one of the Parties notifies other Party of its intention to terminate the Agreement.

The Party intending to terminate this Agreement shall give the other Party a written notice of termination and the Agreement shall remain in force for period of six months.

This Agreement shall be signed in in two copies for each Party.
